### Training

- **Quality Job Program** - The Quality Job Program promotes economic development by encouraging businesses to create well-paid jobs. Rebates up to 6% of gross annual payroll for new jobs & may rebate state's 4% sales/use tax. Annual refundable credit of up to 5 percent of payroll for a period of up to 10 years.
- **Incumbent Worker Training Program** - The program is designed to benefit business and industry by assisting in the skill development of existing employees and increasing employee productivity and the growth of the company through customized training. Company must have been in business for at least 3 years in LA, paying, and in full compliance with LA UI tax system. Business or group of businesses must have at least 15 employees to train during contract.
- **Small Business Training Program** - The IWTP Small Business Employee Training Program (SBET) is designed to benefit businesses with less than 50 LA employees by assisting in the skill development of existing employees through individual, standardized (off the Shelf) training. Training costs cannot exceed \$3,000 and employers are reimbursed for tuition and required textbooks and manuals. Company must have been in business for at least 3 years in LA, paying, and in full compliance with LA UI tax system.
- **Workforce Business Training Program** - Provides funding for customized workforce training programs for Louisiana businesses that have either been operating in LA less than 3 years, companies located outside of Louisiana locating a facility within the state, or expansion of an existing Louisiana company, by the addition of a new technology or product line, can be considered. Must create a minimum of 10 net new jobs. (Excludes retail, gaming or gambling, trucking, lodging or hospitality, assisted living or nursing homes and retirement communities).
