

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, July 11, 2024, AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, July 11, 2024. All council members and Mayor were present.

Councilman Domingue led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Roy motioned to accept the minutes from the June 6, 2024, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion approved.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the minutes from the special meeting held on June 26, 2024, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion approved.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the May 2024, Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Domingue.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering and Mr. Austin Doucet, Fenstermaker & Assoc. gave a brief update on on-going projects.

Mayor Richard stated that there would be a voter's registration drive held at Acadiana High School for juniors and seniors later this month in July.

Mayor Richard led the discussion on the sewer connection and required smoke test for the trailer park located at 120 Des Jacque Road. Trailer Park owner Shawn Tompson was present to request a variance to the required smoke test. Mr. Tompson stated that he was against doing the smoke test. He then presented the council with an alternative method used in the oil and gas industry, "a barrel in; a barrel out." After a lengthy discussion, the council did not grant a variance to the smoke test. Councilman Boudreaux motioned that the required smoke test be done by a licensed plumber and any remaining items on the punch list be completed by August 1, 2024. Motion seconded by Councilman Moreau, carried unanimously.

Councilman Domingue introduced Ordinance 2024-15, an Ordinance amending Chapter 30 Streets, Sidewalks, and other Public Places of the Scott Municipal Code specifically to add Article VII. Public Parks. Ordinance 2024-15 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for August 1, 2024, at 6pm.

Councilman Moreau motioned to grant the Code Exception to Champagne Valve Supply located at 107 Park West Drive. Mayor Richard stated that this item was approved by the Planning Commission unanimously. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Moreau motioned to appoint Mr. Brad Duhon to the Scott Planning Commission for a 5-year term starting July 17, 2024, to July 17, 2029. Mayor

Richard stated that four resumes had been reviewed and that this appointment would be replacing Mr. Kirk Prejean, whom had served for eleven years. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt the official municipal journal – *The Daily Advertiser*. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:42 pm.
