

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, July 2, 2026, AT 6:00 PM**

The City Council met in regular session on Thursday, June 4, 2026. Mayor Richard was absent and all council members were present. Mayor Pro-Tem Moreau ran the meeting.

Councilman Domingue led the prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Roy moved to approve the minutes of the June 4, 2026, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, the motion was approved by majority.

Councilman Montoucet moved to approve the minutes of the special June 23, 2026, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, the motion was approved by majority.

Councilman Domingue moved to accept the May 2026 financial statement. Seconded by Councilman Roy, the motion carried by majority.

Mr. Mark Savoy of Groom's Engineering and Mr. Dustin Guidry of Fenstermaker & Associates gave a brief update on ongoing projects.

Councilman Goodwin motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-6, An Ordinance amending the City of Scott Land Use Map. Mrs. Bonnie Anderson, Planning and Zoning Facilitator, explained that this is changing the zoning for Colt, Inc. to industrial zone. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-7, An Ordinance amending Ordinance 2017-11 to adopt a salary schedule and pay plan for the employees of the City of Scott Fire Department. No questions or comments. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Roy motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-8, An Ordinance amending Ordinance 2017-15 to adopt a salary schedule and pay plan for the municipal employees of the City of Scott (excluding Police and Fire Departments). No questions or comments. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Goodwin motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-19, A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Scott, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana to reappoint Preston Bernard to the Scott City Planning/ Zoning Commission. Mr. Bernard will be sworn in at the next Planning Commission to start his five-year term. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Roy motioned to award the lowest bid for the Apollo Road extension utilities- Phase 2 to NCMC, LLC in the amount of \$3,787,000. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Moreau led the discussion regarding the 2026 Millage rate. The council presented two items for discussion, keep the current millage rate as is, at 4.32 mils or roll forward to 4.47 mils. Mrs. Brenda Dugas, City manager, stated that by rolling up to 4.47 mils it would generate approximately \$17,500 annually. Discussion item died for lack of motion.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:23 p.m.
