

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL  
THURSDAY, June 4, 2026, AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council met in regular session on Thursday, June 4, 2026. Mayor Richard and all council members were present.

Councilman Domingue led the prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Goodwin moved to approve the minutes of the May 7, 2026, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, the motion was approved unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet moved to accept the April 2026 financial statement. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Mark Savoy of Groom's Engineering and Mr. Dustin Guidry of Fenstermaker & Associates gave a brief update on ongoing projects.

Mayor Richard announced several community events scheduled for the coming month. Such as the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration scheduled for June 26, 2026 and Village Beats a concert series during the month of October.

Mr. Francis Touchet Jr, Superintendent of LPSS gave an update on the construction of Acadiana High and other news for schools in the Scott area. No action was taken.

Councilman Domingue introduced Ordinance 2026-4, Amended Budget Ordinance FYE 6/30/26. Ordinance 2026-4 will be up for adoption at the next special council meeting scheduled for Tuesday June 23, 2026 at 6pm.

Councilman Roy Domingue introduced Ordinance 2026-5, Budget Ordinance FYE 6/30/27. Ordinance 2026-5 will be up for adoption at the next special council meeting scheduled for Tuesday June 23, 2026 at 6pm.

Councilman Goodwin introduced Ordinance 2026-6, Amending Land Use map. Ordinance 2026-6 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for Thursday, July 2, 2026 at 6pm.

Councilman Goodwin motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-12, A Ceremonial Resolution of the City Council of the City of Scott, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana establishing a sister city relationship between the City of Scott, Louisiana and the City of Ploemeur, France. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-13, A Resolution of the City Councilman of the City of Scott, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana to adopt the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program Policies and Procedures. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Roy motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-14, A Resolution of support for the St. Mary Street overlay, striping, and related improvements; and providing for other matters related thereto. Mayor Richard that this project is estimated to take place in FYE 29-30 and would include overlay from Cameron St. to Promise Way Rd. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Domingue motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-15, A Resolution giving preliminary approval to the issuance of Taxable Sales Bonds (DEQ) of the City of Scott, State of Louisiana in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding Fifty-Five Million Dollars (\$55,000,000) and providing for other matters in connection therewith. Mr. Shaun Toups, Municipal Financial Advisor and Mr. Brennan Black, Foley & Judell, Associates were present to answer questions. Mr. Toups stated that the interest rate would be 0.95% and the first series would be \$20 million in the fall of this year. No questions from the Council or public. Seconded by Councilman Moreau, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-16, A Resolution approving the appointment of a director and an alternate director to represent the City of Scott, State of Louisiana, on the Board of Directors of the Louisiana Municipal Natural Gas Purchasing and Distribution Authority as provided by Chapter 10-b of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950. Mayor Richard stated that he would serve as the Director and Drew Courville, Gas Supervisor would serve as the alternate. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Goodwin motioned to change the August 6<sup>th</sup> regular council meeting to August 13<sup>th</sup>. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Moreau motioned to approve Substantial Completion for the overlay of Dulles Drive. Ragin Engineering served as the engineer of the project and construction was awarded to Glen Lege. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:29 p.m.
