

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, April 1, 2026, AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, April 1, 2026. Mayor Richard and all council members were present except Councilman Moreau was absent.

Councilman Domingue led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the minutes from the March 5, 2026, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion approved by majority.

Councilman Domingue motioned to accept the February 2026, Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Roy. Motion carried by majority.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering and Mr. Dustin Guidry Fenstermaker & Assoc. gave a brief update on on-going projects.

Mayor Richard announced several community events scheduled for the upcoming month.

Mayor Richard presented a Proclamation recognizing school bus drivers and support staff.

Mrs. Emilia Pardo, candidate for Lafayette City Court Judge, asked for support in the upcoming election.

Mr. Kert Thomas, candidate for Chief of Police, for the City of Scott asked for support in the upcoming November election.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-5, A Resolution of the City of Scott, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana to appoint Jakob Goodwin to fill the unexpired term of Doyle J. Boudreaux to the City Council. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried by majority.

Magistrate Lassiegne swore Councilman Jakob Goodwin in and he took his seat at Councilman for District 1.

Councilman Domingue motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-1, An Ordinance amending Chapter 22, manufactured housing of the Scott Municipal Code to amend and revise Section 22-19, 22-21, and section 22-23. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Domingue motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-2, An Ordinance amending appendix C of the Scott Municipal Code to revise, enact and adopt fines and penalties for traffic and misdemeanor violations committed within the corporate limits of the City of Scott. Seconded by Councilman Roy motion carried by majority.

Fire Chief Chad Sonnier gave a presentation on the Scott Fire Department staffing, salaries, and schedules of employees. No action taken or any comments.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-6, A Resolution authorizing the mayor to negotiate and execute a contract with True North Emergency Management, LLC for disaster debris monitoring. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Roy motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-7, A Resolution authorizing the disposal of certain movable properties owned by the City of Scott and no longer needed for public purposes. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Montoucet introduce Ordinance 2026-3, the Atmos Energy Franchise agreement. Ordinance 2026-3, will be up for introduction at the next regular council meeting scheduled for Thursday, May 7, 2026 at 6pm.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to deny variance request for signs at 1811 Apollo Road, Grab N Geaux #35. Mr. Ed Amo was present on Mr. Rahim Hashim's behalf. After a lengthy discussion, motion was seconded by Councilman Roy, carried by majority.

Councilman Roy motioned to deny the variance request for flagpole at 1811 Apollo Road, Grab N Geaux #35. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, motion carried by majority.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:56 pm.
