

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, December 4, 2025, AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, December 4, 2025. Mayor Richard, all council members, was present.

Councilman Domingue led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the minutes from the November 6, 2025, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion approved unanimously.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the October 2025, Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Domingue. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Richard announced several community events scheduled in the upcoming month such as Scott Mardi Gras Parade and Christmas in Scott.

Chief Chad Leger presented police officer Robert Battles, School Resource Officer at Acadiana High School a lifesaving award and medal.

Councilmember Domingue motioned to adopt Ordinance 2025-11, An ordinance to create General, Sec. 14, Article IX. Landscaping maintenance on commercial and retail property of the Scott Municipal Code. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Ordinance 2025-12, an Ordinance amending Appendix C of the Scott Municipal Code to revise, enact and adopt fines and penalties for traffic and misdemeanor violations committed within the corporate limits of the City of Scott. Seconded by Councilman Roy motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Ordinance 2025-13, an Ordinance amending the Scott Municipal Code to amend Chapter 30 Article III- Parades. Mayor Richard stated the changes included increasing the quantity of allowed floats from 60 to 80, eliminating cars only allowing regulation sized floats, and no changes to the route. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried unanimously.


Councilman Montoucet motioned to award the bid for the I-10 South Frontage Road overlay and reconstruction to Elliott Construction in the amount of \$969,161.50. Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering stated that this project was funded by Capital Outlay Funds and will consist of the stretch between Park West to Mills Road.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to award substantial completion for the Apollo Road, Lebesque Road, and Rue Des Amis Road overlays. Glen Lege Construction completed the project with a final construction cost of \$793,367.15. Seconded by Councilman Moreau, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Domingue motioned to change the January 1, 2026, meeting to January 8, 2026. No discussion or comments. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to change the February 5, 2026, meeting to February 12, 2026. No comments or discussion. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:31pm.
