MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL THURSDAY, April 2, 2020, 2020 AT 6:00 PM

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, April 2, 2020, Councilmen Hollier was absent.

Councilman Bergeron led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the minutes from the meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion approved by majority.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Ordinance 2020-5, an Ordinance enlarging the boundaries of the City of Scott, Louisiana which includes thirty homes on Octavia Drive/ Pitt Road Area. Homeowners will be notified and will be official thirty days after publication.

Councilman Boudreau motioned to adopt Resolution 2020-16, a Resolution to consider a one cent sales tax proposition to benefit Police and Fire Departments to be put on the November 3rd, 2020 ballot. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to approve the substantial completion for the LA HWY 93 Force Main Project. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, carried by majority.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to amend the budget out of LACE \$3,500 to purchase a new Stalker Radar for a new police unit. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, carried by majority.

Councilman Montoucet introduced Ordinance 2020-7, an Ordinance amending Chapter 40 Land Use Code, Sec. 40-21. Definitions, to add a definition for portable storage buildings, and to prohibit portable storage buildings in all land use districts, except for the industrial land use district. Six months will be given to comply with the new ordinance if approved. Ordinance 2020-7 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting, Thursday, May 7th, 2020 at 6pm tune in via our website, www.cityofscott.org then click on the "LIVE" link on the top tabs. Public comments and questions will be accepted by dialing in to 337.889.5022 during the meeting time.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to adopt Resolution 2020-14, A Resolution providing for the abandonment of a portion of a utility servitude located at 315 Des Jacques Road, Scott Louisiana. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried by majority.

Mr. Ryan Hebert, property owner of 1041 Dugas Road requested a variance to Section 8-163 Prohibition of recreational park trailers to allow the parking

of a recreational trailer for the time needed to build a new home. Seconded by Councilman Bergeron, motion carried by majority.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 6:35pm.
