MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL THURSDAY, March 3, 2022 AT 6:00 PM

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, March 3, 2022, all other Councilmen were present.

Councilman Hollier led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the minutes from the February 3, 2022 meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion approved.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the January 2022 Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Suire.

The Mayor's Report consisted of reporting several upcoming events; Drainage Workshop at Scott Events Center on March 30th, Cleanest City- judging will be April 4th-8th, Boudin Festival- April 22nd-24th and National Day of Prayer-May 5th at Events Center from 11am-1pm. He also announced that the City of Scott has been awarded a \$1.2 million for replacing, improving, and expanding water infrastructure along the Frontage Rd.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering and Mr. Josh Broussard gave a brief update on on-going projects.

Mayor Richard presented a Proclamation declaring March 21st National Downs Syndrome Day.

Mayor-President Josh Guillory gave an update of Lafayette Parish and projects specially impacting the city of Scott.

Councilman Suire motioned to adopt Ordinance 2022-1, an ordinance enlarging the boundaries of the City of Scott, Louisiana (City of Scott/ LA 93 Dulles Drive Area) Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Steve Villavaso presented the kickoff plan for the 2022 Comprehensive Master Plan that will be finalized later this year.

Councilman Boudreaux introduced Ordinance 2022-2, an Ordinance amending Ordinance 1989-1 and 1994-3, 2022-3, and 2012-14 reapportioning single member voting districts for the City Council for the City of Scott, Louisiana, in accordance with the 2020 Census. All councilmen attended a workshop led by Mr. Mike Heffner to openly discuss ideas and concerns with new district boundaries keeping in mind new growth. Ordinance 2022-2, will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for April 7, 2022 at 6pm.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to award the contract LA 93: US 90 Benoit Patin Road gas and water relocations to C0-D Construction in the amount of \$141,307.11. Seconded by Councilman Bergeron motion carried by majority. Councilman Suire recused himself due to nephew working for the company.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to approve appeal with the restriction of hours of operation being as follows Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm; weekends 9am -6pm. A lengthy discussion took place. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried by majority. Councilman Hollier voted against.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 8:08 pm.
