

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, February 4, 2021 AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in regular session, Thursday, February 4, 2021. All Councilman and the Mayor was present. Councilman Hollier led the Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to approve the minutes of the January 7, 2021 Council Meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the December 2020 Finance Report. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Mayor's Report included the announcement of Legend's opening and the new dates for the Boudin Festival are September 24, 25, & 26th. The Mayor also asked everyone to engage and participate in a Litter & Recycle Campaign sponsored by the Kiwanis of Scott.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering reported that work for the pump station and force mains for the new subdivision, Berchmans Oaks are underway. The overlay of Westgate should be complete by mid-March. Mrs. Anna Doucet, Fenstermaker & Associates. Reported that the channel cleaning of Ile de Cannes from Dulles Drive to Fenetre Rd. will be bid out by the end of March. She also stated that the traffic study data collection is complete for LA 93- I-10 to Renaud and under review.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-1, an ordinance of the City of Scott, Louisiana, granting unto Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government a non-exclusive franchise for the construction, maintenance and operation of poles, wires and appurtenances for electric transmission and distribution in the City of Scott, Louisiana. Seconded by Councilman Suire motion failed. Councilman Montoucet, Councilman Hollier, and Councilman Bergeron voted not in favor.

Chief Chad Leger presented the Mayor and Council the 2020 Crime Report.

Councilman Montoucet motioned the appointment of the Governing Authority Board representative to the Civil Service Board. Mr. Kert Thomas accepted the three-year term and was sworn in by Mr. William Babin, City Attorney. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion carried unanimously.


