

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, October 2, 2025, AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, October 2, 2025. Mayor Richard, all council members were present.

Councilman Domingue led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the minutes from the September 4, 2025, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion approved unanimously.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the August 2025, Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Roy. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Richard announced several community events scheduled in the upcoming month such as Village Beats, Halloween in Scott, Acadiana Eats Festival, Public Drainage Meeting, Grand Opening of the Veterans Memorial. Please see a complete list on the city website with dates and times.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to approve to adopt Resolution 2025-24, a Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a cooperative endeavor agreement between the State of Louisiana and City of Scott regarding bridge replacement and overlay, planning and construction (Lafayette), and to act on behalf of the City of Scott in all disbursements (FP&C Project No. 50-MQ8-25-01). Mayor Richard explained that this is for the bridge repair/replacement on Delhomme Avenue. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried unanimously.


Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Resolution 2025-25, A Resolution authorizing the increase of the indigent defender fee as per the provisions of Louisiana Revised Statute 15:168. Chief Leger stated that this would increase ten dollars per citation. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Domingue motioned to adopt Resolution 2025-26, A Resolution authorizing the donation of a 2016 white Ford XPL to the City of Kaplan. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux motion carried unanimously.


Councilman Roy introduced Ordinance 2025-10, An Ordinance annexing the property owned by the Lafayette Parish School System located adjacent to Acadiana High School. No discussion. Ordinance 2025-10 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for November 6, 2025 at 6pm.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to amend the budget in the amount of \$5,000 (10-75-7100-1) for improvements in City Hall council chambers. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried unanimously.
