

New Services offered in Scott Bulk & Yard Waste Services to begin the 1st week in September

The new Bulk and Yard
Waste schedule will be:

Wednesday: North of I-10
Thursday: South of I-10

**Please keep yard waste and
bulk piles separate*

Bulk: Acceptable Items

- Power Wheels (remove battery)
- Any small empty box (or boxes)
- Ceiling fans
- Air conditioners, window unit only
- Area rug (one-piece construction, rolled and taped)
- Backboard for basketball goal
- Base for movable basketball goal
- Carrying cage for large dog
- Frame for movable swimming pool (rolled, taped, and/or tied, and weigh less than 50 pounds)
- Full-length dressing mirror
- Large appliances
- Large empty boxes used for appliances, TVs, etc.
- Large ice chest or storage container (both empty)
- Large plastic children's toys
- Liner for movable swimming pool (must be cut, rolled, taped or tied, and each piece weigh less than 50 pounds)
- Manual garbage cans (must be empty and labeled "discard this can")
- Microwave oven
- Patio umbrellas
- Plastic floor fans
- Residential furniture (including lawn furniture)
- Television sets
- Trampoline mat (rolled and taped)
- Vacuum cleaners
- Wading pool (rolled and taped)

Unacceptable:

- Built-in cabinets
- Gas cans/Oil containers
- Construction debris
- Demolition debris
- Fencing (wooden, plastic, or metal)
- Lawn mowers
- Metal pole for basketball goal
- Swing sets
- Tires
- Toilets
- Treadmills

Yard Waste

- ✓ Only tree wood, grass, weeds, and shrub clippings will be picked up as yard waste.
- ✓ No trash is to be mixed in with yard waste.
- ✓ Branches/limbs should be cut no longer than six feet. Limbs can be no larger than 18 inches in diameter, and if a limb is 18" in diameter, it should be cut into two-foot sections. Do not tie or bundle any branches. Simply stack them neatly in front of your house, as far away from your garbage can as possible.
- ✓ No single item can weigh over 50 pounds.
- ✓ Smaller items such as grass and shrub clippings should be put into a yard bag, or you may place smaller yard debris into a garbage can, and leave the top off so the truck driver can identify it as yard waste.
- ✓ Garbage cans used for yard waste can be no larger than 35 gallons. Garbage cans full of yard waste cannot exceed 50 pounds. Bags full of yard waste cannot exceed 35 pounds.
- ✓ Please place regular garbage and your yard waste as far apart as possible on the curb.
