

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, March 5th, 2026, AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, , 2026. Mayor Richard and all council members were present.

Councilman Domingue led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Roy motioned to accept the minutes from the February 12, 2026, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion approved unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the January 2026, Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering and Mr. Dustin Guidry Fenstermaker & Assoc. gave a brief update on on-going projects.

Mayor Richard announced several community events scheduled in the upcoming month such as Easter Bash at City Hall held on Sunday, March 29th 1-3pm. Along with presenting an special recognition award for Councilman Boudreaux.

Councilman Boudreaux announced his new seat as State Representative for District 39. He will be sworn in on Monday, March 9, 2026. Current Representative Julie Emerson was promoted by the Governor to serve as Chief of Staff.

Mayor Richard presented a proclamation for Down Syndrome Awareness.

Mayor Richard and Councilman Boudreaux gave special recognition to Gavin McBride on achieving his Eagle Scout.

Mr. Brun Lavergne and Ms. Michelle Jaqua with Vision Class I presented their class project on the future of L. Leo Judice Elementary school. No action taken.

Mr. Daniel Noel presented on behalf of Vision Class II's class project on Geo Fencing. No action taken.

Mayor Richard presented the "State of Scott" which can be viewed on our website.

Mr. Randy Lasseigne, City Attorney sworn in Civil Service appointments as follows: Mr. Christopher Galvez for Scott Police Department and Mr. Shane Leger for Scott Fire Department.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-3, A Resolution of the city council of the City of Scott, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana, supporting the display of the official National Motto "IN GOD WE TRUST" in the Scott Council Chambers in a prominent location at City Hall. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-4, A Resolution pertaining to the MWPP Environmental Audit Report, required for Louisiana Pollution Discharge Elimination System (LPDES) Permit number LA0034495. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Domingue introduced Ordinance 2026-1, an Ordinance amending Chapter 22, Manufactured housing of the Scott Municipal Code to amend and revise Section 22-19, 22-21, and section 22-23. Ordinance 2026-1 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for April 1, 2026 at 6pm.

Councilman Boudreaux introduced to adopt Ordinance 2026-2, An Ordinance amending appendix C of the Scott Municipal Code to revise, enact and adopt fines and penalties for traffic and misdemeanor violations committed within the corporate limits of the City of Scott. Chief Leger explained that the Judicial College increased their fees from \$0.50 to \$2.50. Ordinance 2026-2 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for April 1, 2026 at 6pm.


