

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL  
THURSDAY, June 4, 2020, 2020 AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, June 4, 2020, all Councilmen were present.

Councilman Bergeron led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the minutes from the May 7, 2020 meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion approved.

Councilman Suire motioned to accept the April 2020 Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Bergeron motion approved.

The Mayor's Report advising everyone to stay safe during upcoming tropical storm and sandbags are available at the Public Works building.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering reported that L. Provost Road has been re-opened and that easement agreements are still being drafted for the sewer extensions planned.

Mrs. Anna Doucet reported that the wetland permit has been received and construction will begin soon for the L8C Provost Pond. Utility Relocation work is moving forward for Apollo Phase 2 and 3.

Councilman At-Large Bergeron gave a brief update on the Census 2020.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Ordinance 2020-8, amending Appendix, A- Permit fee schedule of the Scott Municipal Code to adopt fees for applications requesting abandonment of servitudes, easements, and rights-of-way. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Hollier motioned to adopt Ordinance 2020-6, authorizing the Mayor to enter a contract for emergency and non-emergency ground ambulance services between the City of Scott and Acadian Ambulance Service, Inc. All parties agreed that this would be a great collaboration. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Ordinance 2020-10, extending the moratorium on the approval of property for use as an automobile/vehicle dealership. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried.

Ordinance 2020-11, to adopt the amended Budget Ordinance-FYE 6/30/20 was introduced by Councilman Montoucet. Ordinance 2020-11 will be up for adoption at the next regular Council Meeting scheduled on Thursday, July 2, 2020 at 6pm.

Ordinance 2020-12, Budget Ordinance FYE 6/30/21 was introduced by Councilman Boudreaux. Ordinance 2020-12 will be up for adoption at the next regular Council Meeting scheduled on Thursday, July 2, 2020 at 6pm.


Councilman Suire motioned to re-appoint Mr. Mark Moreau to the Scott Planning Commission for a 5-year term beginning July 17, 2020. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to award the 2019 Roadway Patching and Overlay Project to Elliott Construction LLC. In the contract amount of \$327,874.50. The overlay project will include the roadway Renaud Drive to Heide Circle, LA 725 (Renaud Drive) in the corporate limits, and N. Ambassador Caffery Pkwy in the corporate limits. A map is available for viewing at City Hall. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.


Councilman Suire motioned to adopt Resolution 2020-17, A resolution authorizing the mayor to execute an intergovernmental agreement between the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and the City of Scott concerning the operation and maintenance of the traffic signal at the intersection of Eraste Landry Road and Westgate Road. No Discussion. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to grant a request of variance to the Mobile Home Ordinance Section 8-84 to allow for setbacks of less than 50 ft. from property boundaries. Mr. Kyle Lacombe, property owner at 128 Roger Road asked the council for a variance. All councilman spoke in favor of the variance because it was on the outskirts of the corporate limits. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 6:36pm.
