

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, November 7, 2019 AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, November 7, 2019 following Public Hearing, all Councilmen were present.

Councilman Bergeron led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to accept the Regular Minutes of October 3, 2019 with the correction to the minutes regarding Resolution 2019-14. Let the record reflect the correction as follows; "Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2019-14, A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a Sewer Collection System Extension Servitude Agreement between John Edward Caldwell, Jr., Mona Anne Stutes Caldwell Family Trust and the City of Scott. Donation of the sewer easements are for the new sewer gravity and force mains funded by the W. Willow Sewer Extension Grant. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motioned carried unanimously." Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion approved.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the Special Meeting of October 23, 2019 minutes as written. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion approved.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to accept the Financial Statement of September 2019 as written. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion approved.

The Mayor's Report included announcing Christmas in Scott will be held in front of City Hall on Sunday, December 1, 2019 from 3-6pm. Also, Lafayette Consolidated Government will be cleaning the channel from Sunset to Perez going south, with completion by December 2019. Farm Store will host it's Grand Opening on November 16th from 1-4pm.

Ms. Kelly Courville with the 2020 Census informed the public the importance, different ways to complete the Census, and deadlines.

Mayor Richard presented the Cub Scout Pack 451 and Girl Scouts a certificate for their service in helping with the "Sweep Scott" campaign held earlier in the year.

Jeanne Hornsby, with Fenstermaker & Assoc. gave an update on Apollo Road that now has sidewalks and work is still being done but is on schedule to be completed in March 2020. Engineers have received approval from DOTD to get a temporary signal light at Eraste Landry and Westgate Road Intersection which will start in May 2020. The first round of plans for the Apollo Road Roundabout has been submitted to DOTD on November 7th.


Councilman Hollier motioned to amend the budget in the amount of \$7,400 plus the \$36,000 for a total of \$43,400 for computers. This amended line item will be paid out the LACE fund stated Chief Leger. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Suire motioned to amend the budget \$35,900 from LACE to replace a vehicle with equipment due to an accident. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Suire motioned to amend the budget \$115,000 from LACE for radio replacement due to old radios becoming obsolete at the end of 2019. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Hollier motioned to amend the budget for \$110,000 for engineering and construction of a traffic signal at Westgate Road and Eraste Landry Road. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 6:49 pm.
