

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, August 1, 2024, AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, August 1, 2024. Mayor Richard and all council members were present except Mayor Pro-Tem Moreau.

Councilman Domingue led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the minutes from the July 11, 2024, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion approved.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the June 2024, Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering and Mr. Dustin Guidry, Fenstermaker & Assoc. gave a brief update on on-going projects.

Chief Leger presented two officers Sgt. Juan Leger and Officer Hunter Ponthier with the Medal of Valor for their bravery and exemplary services in the line of duty.

Councilman Domingue motioned to adopt Ordinance 2024-15, An ordinance amending Chapter 30 Streets, Sidewalks, and other Public Places for the Scott Municipal Code specifically to add Article VII. Public Parks. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried by majority.

Mayor Richard updated the councilman on the Des Jacque Trailer Park discussion from the last months' discussion item. The smoke test was performed, and it was observed that several areas had cracks and leaks. The owner, Chris Thompson, was present and acknowledged the deficiencies. He stated that the plumbing company is working up a quote and will be completing the repairs within two weeks of the date.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Resolution 2024-30, A Resolution accepting an act of dedication of servitudes for the Pines Subdivision Phase I. Mrs. Bonnie Anderson, Comprehensive Plan Facilitator stated that a punch list is prepared, and the final plat will not be approved unless completed. Seconded by Councilman Roy motion carried by majority.

Councilman Roy motioned to adopt Resolution 2024-31, A Resolution accepting an act of dedication of servitudes for Harvest Creek Subdivision. Mrs. Anderson stated that the final plat will not be approved until punch list is approved. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Resolution 2024-32, A Resolution authorizing the mayor to execute an agreement between the State of Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development and the City of Scott regarding entity/ state agreement State Project NO. H. 014908 Federal Aid Project No. H014908 Old Spanish Trail Sidewalk Lafayette Parish. Seconded by Councilman Roy motion carried by majority.


Councilman Boudreaux motioned grant the request for delay in the timeline of construction of the required turn lane. Mrs. Bonnie Anderson read aloud the following list: J. Breaux Enterprises, LLC is requesting a variance for Sutton Place Subdivision (to be located off of Rue de Belier), for a delay in the construction and installation of the required left turn lane from Rue de Belier into the subdivision. The variance request is based on the following requirements: Construction of the required left turn lane must begin no later than 3 months after Rue de Belier is transferred from DOTD to the City of Scott. If construction has not begun within the 3-month period, the city will withhold Certificate of Occupancy until the turn lane construction is complete. Plat approval for Phase 1B and 2 will not be given until the construction of the turn lane is completed. The entrance to the subdivision will include a temporarily raised island that does not allow left turns from Rue de Belier into the subdivision. A sign along Rue de Belier will be installed that prohibits left turns from Rue de Belier into the subdivision. Mr. Jeremy Breaux, owner was present but did not comment or have questions. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to approve the request for variance to the noise ordinance for the Ram Alumni Rag ball Tournament at Scott Park from 6pm-2am to be held on September 27th -29th, 2024. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to approve the Louisiana Compliance Questionnaire. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried by majority.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:31 pm.
