

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, October 7, 2021 AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, October 7, 2021, All Councilmen were present.

Councilman Hollier led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the minutes from the September 2, 2021 meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion approved.

Councilman Hollier motioned to accept the Special Meeting Minutes of September 9, 2021 as written. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion approved.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the Special Meeting Minutes of September 27, 2021 as written. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion approved.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the August 2021 Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Hollier.

The Mayor's Report consisted of inviting the public to attend "Scary Street" scheduled for October 31st and "Dejeuner and Danse" scheduled for October 30th. Please check website for complete list of event details.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering reported on the IGA Ulinor Road should be complete by the next meeting and a bid opening for the overlay of Rue Bon Secours Rd is scheduled for October 26th at 11am in City Hall. Mr. Josh Broussard with Fenstermaker & Associates reported that they are currently working on requesting Capital Outlay funding for the water and sewer for Apollo Road Ph. II and III. As well as CSSI Channel cleaning of Lateral 8 is complete, and a video was shown of the progress in the West Village Development that can also be views on the website.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-12, an ordinance amending section 24-26 and appendix C of the Scott Municipal Code. This ordinance pertains to issuing a misdemeanor fine for the possession of less than 9 grams of marijuana. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Andrew Duhon with the Lafayette Library gave a short presentation on the upcoming library millage renewal which will be on the ballot in the upcoming election.

Councilman Suire motioned to adopt a new millage rate of 4.47 mills, Resolution 2021-30. Mr. Conrad Comeaux, Lafayette Parish Tax Assessor stated that the current millage rate was 4.12 mills. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion carried by majority. Councilman Boudreaux voted against raising the millage.

Councilman Hollier motioned to adopt Resolution 2021-29. A resolution authorizing the mayor to execute a cooperative endeavor agreement and act of sale between Lafayette Parish and the City of Scott for the location of 905 Cayret St. The property is located downtown Scott across the street from the Farmer's Market. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2021-19, A Resolution authorizing the purchase of property owned by Bergeron/ Granger LLC. Which is located at 320 Rue Bon Secours, Scott, Louisiana and authorizing the mayor to execute a credit sale therefor. This item will be on the Bond Commission agenda scheduled for Thursday, October 21st. The 13,000 sq ft building situated on 2.9 acres will become the third Emergency Services Center in the City of Scott.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Resolution 2021-32, a resolution pertaining to the Municipal Water Pollution Prevention (MWPP) environmental audit report, required for Louisiana Pollution Discharge Elimination System (LPDES) permit number LA 0034495. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to adopt Resolution 2021-34, a Resolution accepting that certain act of dedication of streets and servitudes for Emerald Lake, Phase II. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet introduced Ordinance 2021-13, an ordinance amending Chapter 14 environment of the municipal code to more specifically assign the responsibility for any violations of said Chapter 14. Ordinance 2021-13 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for November 4th, at 6pm.

Councilman Boudreaux introduced Ordinance 2021-14, an ordinance amending Chapter 14 environment, to prohibit yard waste commercially cut from being deposited at any location for collection by the City of Scott. Ordinance 2021-14 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for November 4th, at 6pm.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to grant a noise variance to the Noise Ordinance section 14-27 (c) (5), Cameron Street overlay project, DOTD. Mayor Richard stated that this variance would cover the entire construction

project of Cameron Street. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 7:15 pm.
