

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
TUESDAY, June 23, 2026, AT 6:00 PM**

A public hearing was held to discuss the City of Scott amended Budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 2026 and for the new fiscal year ending June 30, 2027. A presentation was given by Mr. Brad Kolder, CPA with Kolder, Champagne, Slaven, and Co. Mr. Kolder stated that expenses and revenues had stayed relatively flat, an increase in capital projects tremendously but would be funded mostly by state capital funding. No action taken. An opportunity for questions, comments, or concerns was available but none from councilmen or public present.

Mayor Richard called the Special Meeting to order.

The Mayor and City Council Members met in special Session, Tuesday, June 23, 2026. Mayor Richard, all council members, was present.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-4, Amended Budget Ordinance FYE 6/30/26. No questions or comments from the public or council members. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-5, the Budget Ordinance for FYE 6/30/27. No questions or comments from the public or council members. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Roy introduced Ordinance 2026-7, An Ordinance amending Ordinance 2017-11 to adopt a salary schedule and pay plan for the employees of the City of Scott Fire Department. Ordinance 2026-7 is up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for Thursday, July 2, 2026, at 6pm.


Councilman Goodwin introduced Ordinance 2026-8, An Ordinance amending Ordinance 2017-15 to adopt a salary schedule and pay plan for the Municipal employees of the City of Scott (excluding Police and Fire Departments). Ordinance 2026-8 is up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for Thursday, July 2, 2026 at 6pm.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-17, a Resolution authorizing the mayor to terminate the contract for firefighting services between the City of Scott and the Scott Volunteer Fire Department dated May 1, 2025 and to execute a new contract for firefighter services between The City of Scott and the Scott Volunteer Fire Department. Mayor Richard stated that the annual amount funded by the City of Scott to the SVFD would increase from \$75,000 to \$100,000, the due date would changed and would renew annually. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-18, A Resolution authorizing the mayor to contract with Neuner and Pate, Attorneys at Law to represent the City of Scott in

that suit entitled: Racetrac, Inc. and Williams Scotsman, Inc. versus the City of Scott. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:57 p.m.
