

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received **ONLY** in the office of the City of Scott, located at 125 Lion's Club Road, Scott, Louisiana 70583, until **two o'clock p.m. (2:00 p.m.) Central Time on the 13th day of May 2026** for the following:

APOLLO ROAD EXTENSION UTILITIES PHASE 2

and shall at that time and place be publicly opened and read aloud at Scott City Hall. Bids received after the above specified time for opening shall not be considered and shall be returned unopened to the sender. Sealed bids may be hand-carried or mailed to the address listed above.

The work shall consist of, but is not limited to, **the construction of approximately 180 linear feet of 2" water main, 1951 linear feet of 8" water main, 4891 linear feet of 12" water main, 1263 linear feet of bored water main, 3524 linear feet 10" sanitary sewer gravity main, 225 linear feet of 12" sanitary sewer gravity main, 37 sanitary sewer manholes, 1958 linear feet of bored sanitary sewer main, 3261 linear feet of 8" sanitary sewer force main, 286 linear feet of 8" bored sanitary sewer force main, and a sanitary sewer lift station along Apollo Road Extension in the City of Scott, starting at the roundabout at Dulles Drive and Apollo Road and ending at JB Road.**

All work is to be completed within **THREE-HUNDRED-FORTY-FIVE (345) WORKING DAYS** from the issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

Copies of the Contract Document including drawings and specifications, except for Section D – "Lafayette Consolidated Government Standard Specifications for Roads, Drainage, Bridges, and Other Infrastructure, 2016 Edition", are available at the office of C.H. Fenstermaker and Associates, L.L.C. located at 135 Regency Square, Lafayette, Louisiana 70508, phone: (337) 237-2200, upon payment of two-hundred-sixteen dollars (\$216.00) per set, payable to **City of Scott**. **NOTE: NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED - ONLY CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS MADE PAYABLE TO CITY OF SCOTT.** Deposits on the first set of documents furnished to bona fide prime bidders will be fully refunded upon the return of documents no later than ten (10) days after receipt of bids. For other sets of documents furnished to bidders, the deposit, less the actual cost of reproduction, will be refunded upon return of the documents no later than ten (10) days after receipt of bids. Plans and specifications shall be available until twenty-four (24) hours before the bid opening date. Questions regarding the bidding documents shall be addressed to C. H. There will be a **non-mandatory pre-bid meeting** at Scott City Hall, located at 125 Lions Club Road, Scott, LA 70583, on **May 7, 2026**, at 2:00 p.m.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond payable to the **City of Scott**, the amount of which shall be five percent (5%) of the bid plus additive alternates. If a bid bond is used, it shall be written by a surety or insurance company currently on the U.S. Department of the Treasury Financial Management Service list of approved bonding companies which is published annually in the Federal Register, or by a Louisiana-domiciled insurance company with at least an A- Rating in the latest printing of the A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide to write individual bonds up to ten percent (10%) of policyholders' surplus as shown in the A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide, or by an insurance company in good standing licensed to write bid bonds which is either domiciled in Louisiana or owned by Louisiana residents. The bid bond shall be issued by a company licensed to do business in Louisiana and who is under contract with the surety company or bond issuer as a licensed agent in this state and residing in this state. The certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond shall be given as a guarantee that the bidder

shall execute the contract, should it be awarded to him, in conformity with the Contract Documents within ten (10) days.

Bids must be signed in accordance with LA RS Title 38:2212(B)5. A Corporate Resolution or Certificate of Authority authorizing the person signing the bid is required to be submitted with the bid. Failure to submit a Corporate Resolution or Certificate of Authority with the bid shall be cause for rejection of the bid.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for at least forty-five (45) days after the time scheduled for the opening of bids. Each bid shall be submitted only on the bid form provided with the specifications. The successful contractor will be required to execute performance and labor and material payment bonds in the full amount of the contract as more fully defined in the bid documents.

Bids will be evaluated by the Purchaser based on LA Bid Law statutes, including the lowest responsible bid submitted which is also in compliance with the bid documents. The City of Scott reserves the right to reject any and all bids or any portions thereof, for just cause as allowed by LA R.S. 38§2214.

Contractors or contracting firms doing work that is classed as “Hazardous Materials” or any sub-classifications, shall be properly licensed when the work to be performed is \$1.00 or more. Contractors or contracting firms submitting bids for work besides Hazardous Materials shall be properly licensed for any work in the amount of \$50,000.00 or more.

All such bidders shall certify that they are licensed contractors under Chapter 24 of Title 37 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 and show their license number on the front of the sealed envelope in which their bid is enclosed. **Contractors for this project shall be licensed for the classification of “MUNICIPAL and PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION”** Bids in the amounts specified above which have not been bid in accordance with the requirements, shall be rejected, and shall not be read. Additional information relative to licensing may be obtained from the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

The City of Scott strongly encourages the participation of DBEs (Disadvantaged Business Enterprise) in all contracts or procurements let by the City of Scott for goods and services and labor and materials. To that end, all contractors and suppliers are encouraged to utilize DBEs in the purchase or sub-contracting of materials, supplies, services, labor, and materials in which disadvantaged businesses are available.
