

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, April 1, 2021 AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, April 1, 2021, all Councilman were present. Councilman Bergeron led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the minutes from the regular Council meeting of March 4, 2021 as written. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion approved.

Council Suire motioned to accept the minutes of the Special Meeting of March 9, 2021 as written. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet.

Councilman Suire motioned to accept the minutes of the Special Meeting of March 25, 2021 as written. Seconded by Councilman Bergeron.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the February 2021 Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet.

Mayor Richard reported that National Day of Prayer would be held at the Scott Events Center on May 6th from 11am-1pm. Also, congratulated CH Fenstermaker/City of Scott for a Grand Award winner for the FEMA map revision work on Coulee Iles Des Cannes Project which removed 300 plus acres from the flood way.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering reported that the relocation of gas service on Cameron and Alfred due to the Cameron St. Overlay being done by DOTD will cost the city about \$60,000 and will go out to bid in June. The final inspection has been done for the Westgate Overlay and still waiting on the final acceptance/ right sizing paperwork to complete the project.

Mr. Josh Broussard with CH Fenstermaker reported that Apollo Road PH II & III will start in May 2021. The FEMA CRS rating went from a Class 9 to 7 which will save over \$90,000/ \$150 annually per flood policy.

Councilman Hollier motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-1, an Ordinance of the City of Scott, Louisiana, granting unto Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government a non-exclusive franchise for the construction, maintenance and operation of poles, wires and appurtenances for electric transmission and distribution in the City of Scott, Louisiana. A lengthy discussion was had from Councilman, Company Representatives, and members of the audience. The motion was Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, then failed. Councilman Hollier voted in favor. Councilman Montoucet, Councilman Bergeron, Councilman Suire voted against, and Councilman Boudreaux abstained.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-2, an ordinance amending Sec 9.03 of the City of Scott 1968 sales and use tax ordinance. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Suire motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-3, an ordinance to amend the City of Scott 1984 sales and use tax ordinance. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-4, an ordinance amending Sec 3 of Ordinance No 2019-20 regarding the sales and use tax levied by the Apollo-Destination Pointe Consolidated Economic Development District. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, carried unanimously.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-5, an ordinance enlarging the boundaries of the City of Scott, Louisiana (Provost Family/ Old Spanish Trail Area.) Seconded by Councilman Bergeron, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to grant the variance, Section 8-84 setback requirements for a mobile home to be located at 101 Jerome Road. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motion to amend the budget for a FEMA reimbursement from Hurricane Laura \$625.00 to be added back to the Police Departments fuel line item (10-15-6223.) Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Hollier motioned to amend the budget for a FEMA reimbursement for a water leak \$3,376.61 in office equipment repairs and maintenance (10-15-6331.) Seconded by Councilman Bergeron, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Hollier motioned to adopt Resolution 2021-12, which is the Dulles Right Sizing Agreement. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried unanimously.


Councilman Montoucet motioned to grant a variance to the noise ordinance Sec 14-27, Apollo Road Phase 2 from May 1, 2021 to June 30, 2023 which will cover all construction activity. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried unanimously.

A discussion on erosion for 4702 Cameron St., Anybody Towing owned by Mr. Thomas Huffman. Mr. Huffman stated that erosion is a major problem impeding on his land that in turns affects the total of cars that can be stored. Mayor Richard has been in contact with Lafayette Consolidated Government to help find a solution. No action taken.

Councilman Suire motioned to amend the budget \$35,000 for line item City Hall repairs and maintenance (10-11-6330). Mayor Richard stated that this was to repair a sprinkler head which froze during the winter storm last month. Seconded by Councilman Bergeron, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to add an amendment to the Fenstermaker Master Service Agreement. The amendment adds rates for a grant manager and a planner. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
