

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, September 3, 2026, AT 6:00 PM**

The City Council met in regular session on Thursday, September 3, 2026. Mayor and all council members were present.

Councilman Domingue led the prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Roy moved to approve the minutes of the August 13, 2026, meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, the motion was approved unanimously.

Councilman Domingue moved to accept the July 2026 financial statement. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Mark Savoy of Groom's Engineering and Mr. Mason Macaluso of Fenstermaker & Associates gave a brief update on ongoing projects.

Mayor Richard announced numerous upcoming events that are all listed on our city website and social media pages.

Candidate for District Court Judge Division I, Mr. Will Keaty asked for support in the upcoming November 3rd, 2026 election.

Candidate for Council District 2, Mrs. Sherie Stutes Sonnier asked for support in the upcoming November 3rd, 2026 election.

Candidate for Council District 4, Mrs. Allyson Soeseno Richard asked for support in the upcoming November 3rd, 2026 election.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-9, An Ordinance amending appendix C of the Scott Municipal Code to revise, enact and adopt fines and penalties for traffic and misdemeanor violation committed within the corporate limits of the City of Scott. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-10, An Ordinance authorizing the issuance of not exceeding Twenty Million (\$20,000,000) of Taxable Sales Tax Bonds (DEQ) of the City of Scott, State of Louisiana, and providing for other matters in connection therewith. Mr. Jason Akers, the bond attorney with Foley & Judell along with Mr. Shaun Toups with Government Consultants were present to answer questions. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Ordinance 2026-11, An Ordinance to amend the Scott Municipal Code to add sections to Chapter 10 Article II for Occupational Licensing. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Roy, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Domingue introduced Ordinance 2026-12, An Ordinance amending the Scott Municipal Code to amend Chapter 14 Article II- Noise. Ordinance 2026-12 will be up for adoption at the next council meeting scheduled for Wednesday, October 7, 2026, at 6pm. No action taken.

Councilman Moreau introduced Ordinance 2026-13, An Ordinance to amend/ replace the Scott Municipal Code Chapter 16 Fire Protection. Ordinance 2026-13 will be up for adoption at the next council meeting scheduled for Wednesday, October 7, 2026, at 6pm. No action taken.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-23, A Resolution authorizing the disposal of a certain movable property owned by the City of Scott and no longer needed for public purposes. Chief Leger stated that this vehicle was a 2017 model with very high milage that will be sent to the next auto auction. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried unanimously.

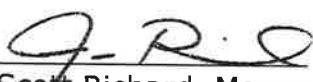
Councilman Roy motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-24, A Resolution authorizing the mayor to execute a drainage servitude, right of drainage, and access easement agreement. Mayor Richard explained that this would be for the Westside Elementary drainage pond. Seconded by Councilman Domingue, motion carried unanimously.

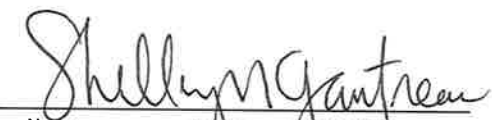
Councilman Moreau motioned to adopt Resolution 2026-25, A Resolution authorizing the mayor to execute a tender and release agreement with the Gray Casualty & Surety Company, the City of Scott and Mitchell Contracting, Inc. and to execute a completion contract with Mitchell Contracting, Inc. Mayor Richard stated that this agreement was for the new contractor being assigned by the Surety Company for the Lions Club Pump station project. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Domingue motioned to change the October 1st council meeting to Wednesday, October 7, 2026. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Moreau motioned to appoint Mr. Barrett Payne to the Lafayette Parish Waterworks District South Board of Commissioners for a 4-year term starting September 4, 2030. Seconded by Councilman Goodwin, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:33pm.
