MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL THURSDAY, August 4, 2022 AT 6:00 PM

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, August 4, 2022, all Councilmen were present.

Councilman Hollier led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the minutes from the July 7, 2022 meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion approved.

Councilman Hollier motioned to accept the minutes from the July 27, 2022 special meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion approved.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the June 2022 Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux.

The Mayor's Report consisted of reporting several upcoming events; Scott Park Ribbon cutting will be August 5th, Dejeuner & Danse' will take place August 6th, and Household Hazardous Waste Day will be Saturday, September 10th from 9am-1pm. Mayor Richard also invited everyone to attend a special announcement that will be given at City Hall on Wednesday, August 17, 2022 pertaining to the LUS Fiber.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering and Mrs. Callie Benton, Fenstermaker & Assoc. gave a brief update on on-going projects.

Councilman Suire motioned to approve and award the bid to Mourain Contruction, LLC to construct Phase I of the Scott Veterans Memorial at the Rail in the amount of \$586,579. Construction will be the first week of September. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Hollier motioned to appoint Mr. Dwain Gannard to a 5-year term on the Scott City Planning Commission effective July 2022. Seconded by Councilman Swire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to approve the code exception for a Classic Carwash located at the 6500 block of Cameron Street. No discussion. Mayor Richard stated that the planning commission did unanimously approve. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to grant a variance to the noise ordinance, Section 14-27 (c) (5), Construction activity (pouring slab for commercial development) located at 809 Apollo Rd. Lt C4 on Tuesday, August 9th to Thursday, August 10th beginning at 2am., weather permitting. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to award the 2022 roadway patching and overlay project to Elliott Construction, LLC in the amount of \$697,223.75. The overlay project will include Mills St. from the overpass to Ulinor Rd. as well as the streets in Golden Meadow subdivision. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Hollier motioned to adopt Resolution 202-15, A Resolution authorizing the sales of a 2013 Chevrolet Tahoe and 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe to the City of Rayne for \$2,000 per unit. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

A lengthy discussion about adding a sidewalk to Anna Street to assist in connectivity to Old Spanish Trail for residents in Acadian Heritage Assisted Living Complex. Councilman Hollier suggested that time be spent on developing a plan, a cost estimate, and right-of-way research for the next fiscal year budget (FYE 2024). Several residents were present and spoke in favor of adding a sidewalk. No action taken.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to grant the request for waiver for The Waters Apartments in the Estates at West Village. Mrs. Bonnie Anderson, Comprehensive Plan Facilitator reported that the Planning Commission denied the wavier. Mr. Jordan Daigle and Mr. Robert Daigle property owners were present to appeal the denial. After a lengthy discussion, Councilman Boudreaux asked how many other times had this same wavier been granted, Mrs. Anderson responded several times in the past. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to grant a variance to Noise Ordinance Section 14-27(c)(5), Construction activity, (working nights to install a larger culvert crossing) Monday, August 8th to Monday, August 15th, weather permitting. The construction work will be done by Glenn Lege Construction, LLC. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Bergeron, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm.
