

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, November 4, 2021 AT 6:00 PM**

The Mayor and City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, November 4, 2021, All Councilmen were present.

Councilman Bergeron led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the minutes from the October 7, 2021 meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion approved.

Councilman Hollier motioned to accept the Special Meeting Minutes of September 9, 2021 as written. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion approved.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the September 2021 Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Hollier.

The Mayor's Report consisted of inviting the public to attend the Inaugural Veterans Day Ceremony on November 11, 2021 at 4pm, to stay tuned to the "Begnaud House" Facebook for upcoming events, and "Christmas in Scott" will be Sunday, December 5th, 2021 from 3-6pm.

Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering and Mr. Josh Broussard gave a brief update on on-going projects.

Mayor Richard gave an introduction of the new employee, Mr. Rick Martinez. Mr. Martinez will serve as the Begnaud House Coordinator.

Councilman Hollier motioned the approval of Financial Report ending June 30, 2021. Mr. Burton Kolder and Mr. Brad Kolder with Kolder, Slaven & Company, LLC presented the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2021 Financial Report. No comments from the public or councilmembers. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Richard lead the Scott Park discussion for plans for in-field turfing, fencing, lighting and improved drainage. All councilmen spoke in favor of proceeding with the improvements and verbally gave the Mayor permission to have a special meeting on Wednesday, November 10 at 5:30pm to enter in a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement by Resolution with Sustainability Partners.

Councilman Montoucet, motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-13, an Ordinance amending Chapter 14 environment of the municipal code to assign the

responsibility more specifically for any violations of said Chapter 14. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, carried unanimously.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Ordinance 2021-14, an ordinance amending Chapter 14 environment, to prohibit yard waste commercially cut from being deposited at any location for collection by the City of Scott. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Bergeron motioned to grant a request for variance to Chapter 40 (Land Use Code) to allow use of property located at 406 Apollo Road for a new RV Storage Facility. Mr. Karl Short presented a rendering to the City Council. A lengthy discussion took place. Councilman Bergeron, Mr. Dean Domingue, co-owner of the property spoke in favor of variance. Mr. Don Hargrave, a resident, Mr. Jacob Goodwin, a resident, Councilman Boudreaux, and Councilman Montoucet spoke not in favor of granting the variance. Mr. Jacob Goodwin, a resident also stated that the Planning Commission voted 4-1 not to grant the variance to Mr. Karl Short at the October 2021 meeting. Motion denied for lack of second. No variance granted.

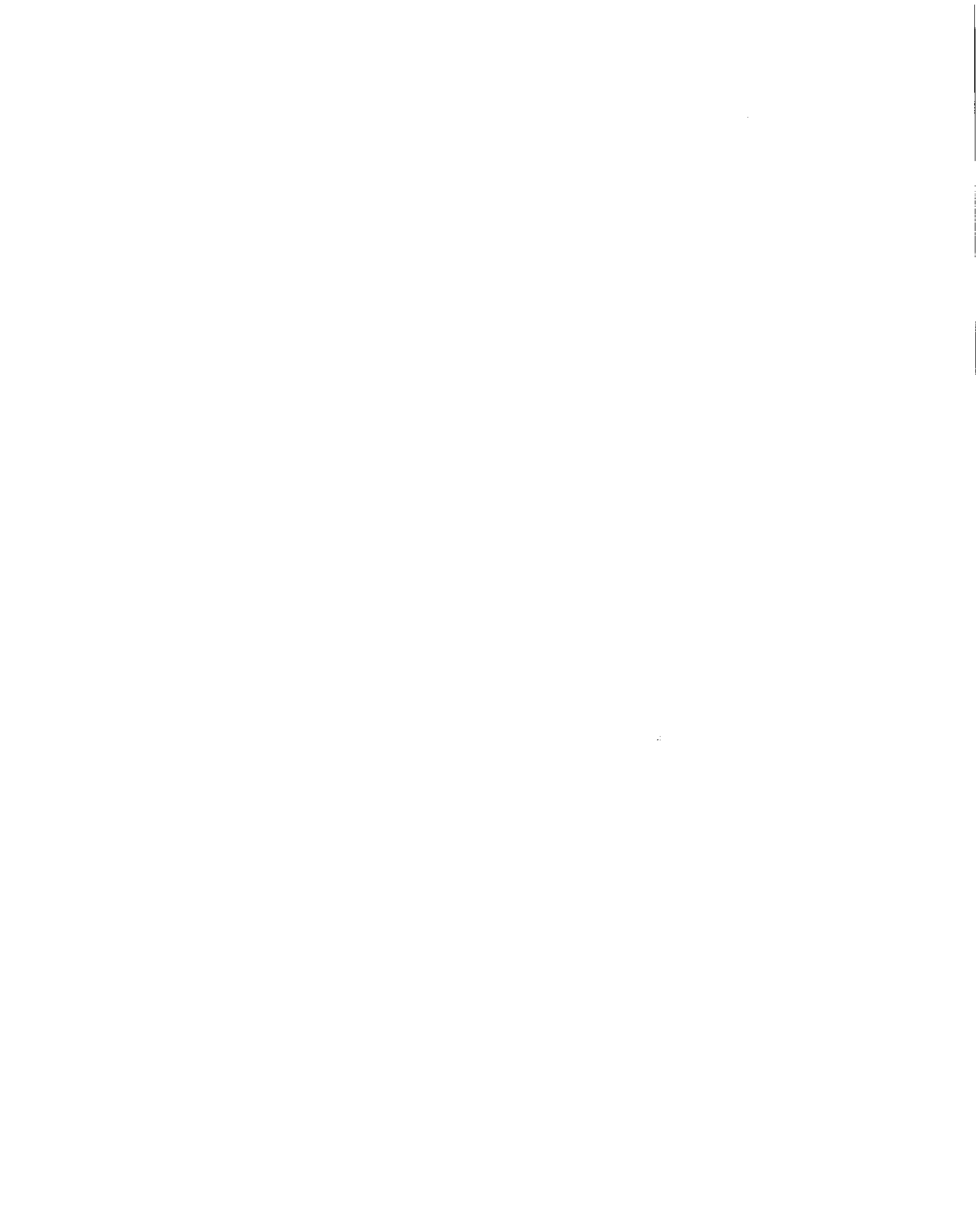
Councilman Bergeron motioned to adopt Resolution 2021-33, A Resolution authorizing the mayor to execute a cooperative endeavor agreement between the City of Scott and the City of Lafayette for the use of a City of Lafayette Fire Department Ladder Truck. No costs involved. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Hollier introduced Ordinance 2021-15, an Ordinance amending Chapter 24 offenses and miscellaneous provisions to add a juvenile curfew. Chief Chad Leger stated that it would be under the age of 18 instead of 17; 1st offense would be a warning to minor and parent; 2nd offense would fine the guardian \$220. Ordinance 2021-15 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for December 2, 2021 at 6pm.

Councilman Suire introduced Ordinance 201-16, an Ordinance amending Chapter 40 (Land Use Code), Article III Land Use Administrative code. The Ordinance would change the development advertising from 10 to 14 days regardless of development. Ordinance 2021-16 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for December 2, 2021 at 6pm.

Councilman Montoucet introduced Ordinance 2021-17, An Ordinance amending Chapter 32 Subdivisions to add Article IV infrastructure regulations and standards for water systems. Ordinance 2021-17 will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting scheduled for December 2, 2021 at 6pm.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to award bid for the 2021 Roadway patching and overlay project on Rue Bon Secours to Glen Leger in the amount of \$499,287.00. Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering stated that this item came in over budget total because of inflation. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried unanimously.




Councilman Bergeron motioned to amend budget \$50,000 Roadway patching and overlay project 2021. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried unanimously.

Assistant Fire Chief Chris Domingue asked the council on behalf of Chief Sonnier to reapply for the Safer Grant. Councilman Boudreaux and Councilman Montoucet stated that the City should not apply for this round of funding. Item died for a lack of motion. Approval not granted to apply for Safer Grant.


Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Resolution 2021-35, A Resolution accepting that certain act of dedication of streets and/or servitudes for Berchman Oaks, Phase I. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried by unanimously.

Councilman Hollier motioned to adopt Resolution 2021-36, A Resolution approving the appointment of a director and an alternate director to represent the City of Scott, State of Louisiana, on the Board of Directors of the Louisiana Municipal Natural Gas Purchasing and Distribution Authority as provided by Chapter 10-B of Title 33 of the Louisiana revised statutes of 1950. Mayor Richard stated that Drew Courville would be appointed as an alternate on behalf of the City of Scott. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
